Shahar Azani is founder and principal at Fourth Dimension Strategies and a Senior Vice President at JBS, Jewish Broadcasting Service, whose mission is to provide for a greater understanding of Jewish life and the State of Israel. Azani was formerly Executive Director for StandWithUs Northeast Region and served as an Israeli diplomat at Israel's Foreign Ministry for over 15 years. He held the position of Consul for Media Affairs and Spokesperson at the Consulate General of Israel in New York as well as Media Officer at the Embassy of Israel in London, Deputy Spokesperson at Israel's Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Jerusalem; Israel's Consul for Culture, Media and Public Affairs in Los Angeles, California; and Deputy Ambassador at the Embassy of Israel in Nairobi, Kenya. Before embarking on this career path, Mr. Azani practiced Law at Haim Zadok and Company, based in Tel Aviv, focusing on litigation. He has a law degree (LLB) as well as a Master's in Business Administration.
