

# FOR A MORE PRIDE-FULL SEDER...

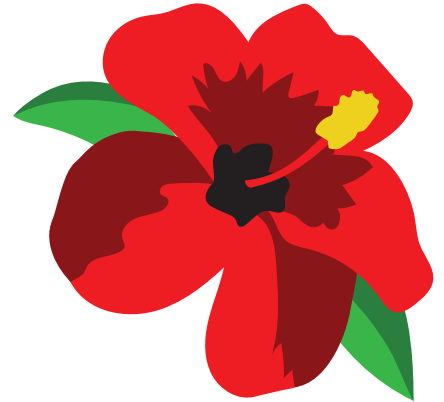
You can add any of these symbols to your seder table to inspire conversations about inclusion.
