Where should I park?

Congregation Kol Ami is located at 252 Soundview Avenue, White Plains, New York. There is free, self-parking on site. Both on-site parking lots have been newly plowed to provide safe and ample parking.

The evening begins at 7:15 PM with a festive culinary reception, followed by the personal introduction of each elected official at 8:15 PM.
